This consultation remains open to Friday, 5 January and final results will be reported to the Overview and Scrutiny Committee at their meeting on 29 January.

Anti-social behaviour in public spaces

The Council is still consulting on whether or not to create a public space protection order.

An order could help enforcement. The police and some council officers will be able to issue on-the-spot fines of £100 instead of complicated and lengthy evidence gathering and taking people to court.

Review of Park Homes Legislation

The Communities and Local Government Department (Government) is undertaking a public consultation on park homes legislation to 16 February 2018. It includes a call for evidence of the effectiveness of local authority licensing, amongst other matters. This is the second round of consultation on park homes.

The Communities and Local Government Department (Government) is consulting until 5 January 2018 on proposals for new statutory guidance for domestic violence victims living in hostels and similar accommodation.

East Sussex County Council are consulting on changes to on-street vehicle parking in Eastbourne. The consultation closes on 22 December 2017. Note – requires downloading documents that must be referred to in responses.
