Everyone is welcome to join these walks, led by some of Battle Ramblers expert walkers who know the locality well and will keep you informed about what can be seen whilst walking around the splendid surrounding High Weald AONB countryside.

The walks are aimed at starting the weekend off with a small glimpse of the wonderful countryside in and around Battle. You will have to be fit enough to climb over a few stiles. It is a good idea to wear suitable footwear – no high heels – better to use good walking shoes or, if broken-in, walking boots. Of course, we cannot guarantee the weather so suitable, layered, clothing makes sense for an evening walk, when the sun is going down and shadows lengthen.
